Please note that the £135 covers your registration and the price of the first vaccination, normally rubella. Vaccination prices are rubella £95, measles £75 and Mumps £120 to be paid in advance.

Please refer to our terms & conditions.

The clinic is located in Worcester close to junction 7 of the M5. A map will be sent to you along with a full information pack.

Your child will need to be at least 13 months old to start this single vaccination programme. If your child was born premature the programme will begin at least 13 months from the due date.

Please note that you will need to reschedule your appointment if your child:

- has a temperature at the time of the appointment
- or is taking or has taken antibiotics in the 2 weeks prior to the appointment date
- or has been in contact with chickenpox in the 2 weeks prior to appointment date
- or has had chickenpox within 3 months prior to an appointment date.

As soon as we receive this form we will contact you to make an appointment.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR SINGLE VACCINATION PROGRAMME WITH DESUMO

These terms and conditions give you more information about your registration and programme of care with Desumo. They outline what is and what is not included in the price.

1. Registration

There is a one off registration fee payable prior to course of treatment of £40. This is a one off registration fee and will cover all children of the family.

Your registration fee covers the following:

- All administrative support engaged with your programme e.g. appointment bookings, vaccination ordering and on course general information
- Comprehensive Information Booklet covering all aspects of the particular vaccination debate
- A Twenty Four Hour, Seven days a week, pre and post vaccination support service

2. The Service

- The service is an alternative children's vaccination programme consisting of single vaccines of rubella, measles and mumps
- The gap between registration and first vaccination varies but is not normally less than 2 weeks
- These will be administered on separate occasions with the following suggested minimum gaps between vaccines
- Six weeks between rubella and measles
- Three months between measles and mumps

Please note that the availability of vaccines is subject to market fluctuations and cannot always be guaranteed. We will inform you of vaccine availability prior to your booking and acceptance of any appointment.

3. Prices

The current price for consultation and administration of vaccine is as follows:

- Rubella £95
- Measles £75
- Mumps £120

Because of the length of the programme prices are subject to fluctuation and you can check the price prior to your appointment by calling the office on 01531 631642.

Payment for each of the consultations and vaccinations will be in advance of the appointment.

4. Refunds

Your registration fee is non-refundable.

Desumo regrets we are unable to make any refund of the vaccination fees where for any non-medical reason the appointment is not attended (see 4.1) This is because both the vaccine and the appointment are for your child only. However appointments may be re-booked at the reduced fee of £50. This fee is also non refundable.

4.1 If your child cannot make an appointment due to any medical illness or condition and this can be substantiated with a GP's letter or by the Desumo G.P your child will be re-appointed into the next clinic

without any rebooking fee.

5. Appointments

You will be provided with an appointment time by letter or in person at a clinic. It is your responsibility to attend this appointment. It is your responsibility to ensure that prior to attending the clinic your child is in good health to receive a vaccination. If you have any concerns then you must contact Desumo prior to the appointment. Please note there is a reappointment charge of £50 to reschedule any appointment and must be paid prior to the rescheduled appointment.

At or prior to your appointment you will be given a patients medical history form to complete, it is your responsibility to provide these details. We cannot be held responsible if you withhold information and you must provide the necessary and relevant information when asked for by your doctor or nurse.

Desumo regrets we are unable to make any refund of the vaccination fees where for any reason the appointment is not attended due to non-medical reason/s. This is because both the vaccine and the appointment are for your child only.

If you fail to attend the rearranged appointment without notifying us, we reserve the right to cancel your registration without reimbursement and you will be deemed to have withdrawn yourself from our single vaccination programme.

Your registration may also be terminated without reimbursement if you act in a rude and aggressive way either to any member of the Desumo staff or to any other patient or visitor to the clinic and in this instance you will be deemed to have withdrawn yourself from our single vaccination programme. In both these instances a refund of your pre-paid vaccine will be in accord with point 4 above.

6. Information

Information about the actual vaccines is provided in the information pack which is included in the pre-vaccination registration pack. Information about the vaccine is also given to you upon arrival at the clinic. The information pack is provided on the basis that you agree to study the information contained within it prior to your child's treatment.

The clinic is located at The Green Centre, Gresham Road, Worcester, WR2 5QS and normally takes place on the 2nd and 4th Saturday of the month. The pre-vaccination registration pack contains a map of how to find the clinic. In the event of any change to these arrangements you will be notified beforehand.

7. What You Need To Do Before Treatment

Sign and return your programme confirmation letter. This can be brought with you to clinic.

Complete the patient's medical history and consent for treatment form – this is provided at the clinic, but on occasions will be included in our pre appointment correspondence.

Complete the appropriate pre-vaccination patient details and consent form. This will normally be sent to you prior to your appointment. Failure to bring this with you to clinic will incur a replacement charge of £2.50.

Complete your registration details and registration payment

Pay the registration fee and vaccination fee in full prior to your appointment.
